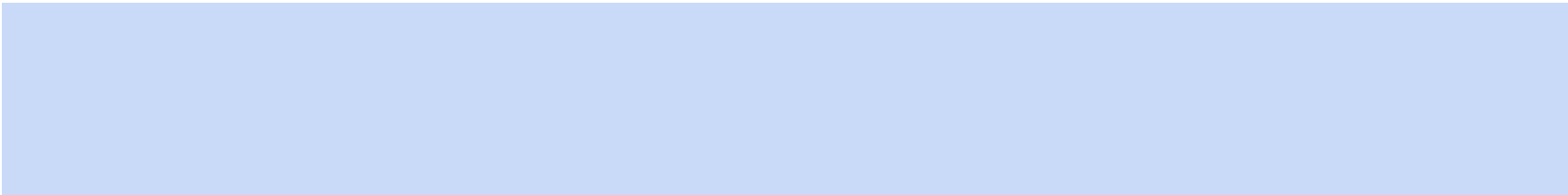
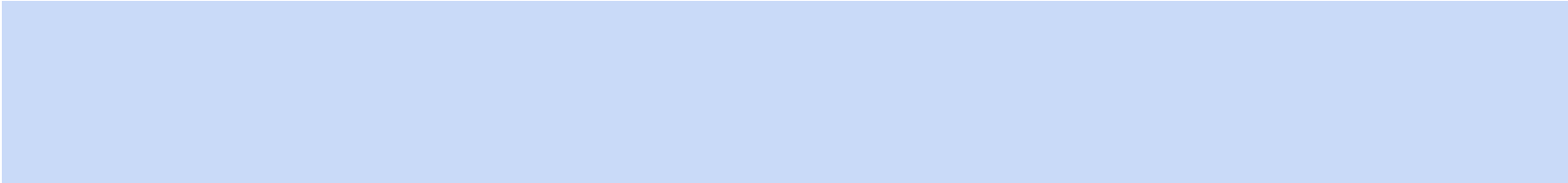

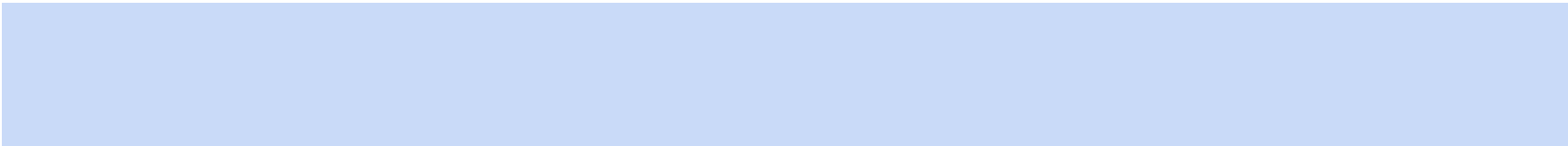
Areas of Spending
